** Archibald Thompson was elected from Philadelphia City but died before the beginning of the Assembly. He was replaced by Joseph Blewer who took his seat on 24 January 1780.

*** Sketchly Morton, John Flemming, and John Culbertson all received the same number of votes. A new election was held in which Morton was elected. He assumed his seat on 2 February 1780.
