Despite the fact that Alexander Irvin had been elected in 1836 to serve the 13th District, comprised of Lycoming, Centre, Clearfield, McKean, and Potter counties, he is listed under the 23rd District in the *Senate Journal* for 1837-1838, rather than under the 12th District, which held the remnants of the old 13th District. This district had been dismantled in the reapportionment of 1836.
