\* James Pemberton, Joshua Morris, William Callender, William Peters, Peter Worral, and Francis Parvin (all Quakers) formally submitted their resignations because “many of our Constituents seem of Opinion that the present Situation of Public Affairs call upon us for services in a military Way, which, from a conviction of Judgement...we cannot comply with...” They were replaced by Thomas Leech, Daniel Roberdeau, William Masters, John Morton, Emanuel Carpenter, and John Potts, who were seated on 29 June 1756.
